MASSIMO VITALI

At more than seven feet across, Vitali's big color photos of busy Italian beaches, pools, and ski slopes are a bit overwhelming in this old-school gallery space. Unable to get as far back from these leisure landscapes as the photographer (perched on a high platform) apparently did, viewers are thrust into the midst of the crowd, where they can enjoy a brief, vicarious vacation.
